Call 911 for Transport

Be Prepared!

Review patient's chart for medications, allergies, medical history, and code status

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SITUATION

- I am (name and title) and I am caring for (patient name and location)
- (Patient name) has (state changes e.g. decline in mentation, a moist, non-productive cough)
- We are concerned about an infection, potential sepsis
- We would like (patient name) transferred to hospital for further evaluation and treatment (N/A for hospital report)

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BACKGROUND

Discuss the patient's:

- ✓ Baseline mental status and any changes (e.g. patient has been confused this morning)
- ✓ Medical history (chronic diseases such as diabetes)
- ✓ Allergies
- ✓ Code status

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ASSESSMENT

- Sepsis symptoms and/or risk factors
- Vitals are (blood pressure, pulse, temperature, oxygen saturation (if on oxygen, how many liters)
- Current treatment while in facility if any (e.g. Tylenol for fever, oxygen and how many liters)
- We are concerned about an infection, potential sepsis

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RECOMMENDATION

- ❖ The provider/family would like patient to be evaluated at nearest hospital
- ❖ I will call report to hospital with positive sepsis screen
- ❖ Family will be updated on patient transfer
- ❖ For hospital report, inform of positive sepsis screen
